The J15 is a special locomotive. It's the workhorse of the North Norfolk Railway, and a treasured asset of the M&GN Joint Railway Society (the loco's owner). Since returning to steam in 2002 the loco has created great interest and excitement across the country: it is the sole surviving member of its class.

JOIN THE LITTLE BLACK GOODS CLUB

Often referred to as the "little black goods" by their crews, the title has since been taken on by the club which supports the loco, and with the overhaul due in a few years we're looking for your support. When you join the club, you'll be helping to support this unique locomotive, and by doing so gain access to a range of benefits:

J15 Shedmasters This five-year membership offers a superb range of benefits:

- Two footplate experience days on the J15 during the membership term.
- Annual Little Black Goods Members' Day, including social, charter and photo opportunities and footplate visits.
- Free rides behind the J15 when it visits other railways (excluding main line tours).
- Annual Christmas card
- Certificate of membership after five years.

J15 Shedmaster membership is restricted to 100 people. Membership is by a single payment of £550 on joining, or by 60 monthly payments of £10 by standing order every month for five years. The Gift Aid scheme is not applicable to J15 Shedmaster members.

J15 Goods members This two-year membership is designed for supporters who prefer to make a shorter commitment. The benefits are:

- One footplate experience day on the J15 during the membership term. (please note that if you sign the Gift Aid Declaration overleaf you will not be entitled to footplate experience days).
- Annual Little Black Goods Members' Day, including social, charter and photo opportunities and footplate visits.
- Annual Christmas card
- Certificate of membership after two years.

J15 Goods membership is by a single payment of £300 on joining, or by 24 monthly payments of £12.50 by standing order every month for two years.

LITTLE BLACK GOODS CLUB GENERAL RULES

- 1 The Club will be known as the 'Little Black Goods Club', and the contents of this leaflet form part of the Club rules.
- 2 There are two categories of membership as detailed in this leaflet. Little Black Goods Shedmaster membership will be restricted to 100 people.
- 3 Membership will be for a minimum period of five years (J15 Shedmaster) or two years (J15 Goods) from the date of a member's first payment, but members paying by monthly standing order may elect to continue their payments and membership beyond five or two years.
- 4 The Club's purpose is to raise funds to assist with the overhaul and continued maintenance of J15 locomotive 65462 which is owned by the Midland & Great Northern Joint Railway Society ('the Society').
- 5 Membership payments are as set out in this leaflet.
- 6 Once collected, funds become the sole property of the Society and are not repayable.
- 7 Members whose subscriptions are in arrears do not qualify for any of the benefits set out in this leaflet, and in the event of a member's subscription not being received within fourteen days of the due date, the Society may cancel that membership.
- 8 The benefits of membership are assignable to a third party subject to written consent of the Society. Any assignee must observe the Club's rules and terms and conditions for benefits.
- 9 In the event of a dispute between a member and the Society, the decision of the Society's Council of Management shall be final.
- 10 A member may terminate membership by giving one month's notice in writing to the Society at its registered office (address below).
- 11 The Society reserves the right to amend, alter or vary the rules from time to time as it sees fit.
- 12 Whilst the Society will make every effort to deliver all the benefits as described in this leaflet, circumstances may dictate that benefits have to be altered or withdrawn for operating or other reasons.
