Loco Club General Rules

- 1 The club will be known as the 'Loco Club' and the contents of this leaflet form part of the Club Rules.
- 2 The Club's purpose is to raise funds to assist with the overhaul and continued maintenance of steam and diesel locomotives owned by the Midland and Great Northern Joint Railway Society ('the Society') from time to time.
- 3 There is no fixed membership term; membership to the club is renewed on a monthly basis through the payment of a monthly standing order.
- 4 Membership payments are set out in this leaflet. Preferred denominations are monthly contributions of £5 or more, however, members are welcome to contribute any denomination upwards of £2 per month.
- 5 Members may specify if they would like their contributions to be applied to an individual locomotive, otherwise funds will be applied to specific locomotives at the discretion of the Society Council. For members wishing to contribute to more than one locomotive, each contribution must be at least £2 per month or more. Monthly donations of less than £2 per month cannot be split.
- 6 Once collected, funds become the sole property of the Society and are not repayable.
- 7 A member may assign a footplate ride to another person subject to approval by either the Loco Club promoter or the Society Council.
- 8 Any prize won in the Prize Draw may not be substituted for money.
- 9 Members whose contributions are in arrears do not qualify for any of the benefits set out in this leaflet, and in the event of a member's contribution not being received within fourteen days of the due date, the Society reserves the right to cancel their membership.
- 10 A member may terminate membership by giving one month's notice in writing to the Society at its registered office (address below).
- 11 In the event of a dispute between a member and the Society, the decision of the Society's Council of Management shall be final.
- 12 The Society reserves the right to amend, alter or vary the rules from time to time as it sees fit.
- 13 Whilst the Society will make every effort to deliver all the benefits as described in this leaflet, circumstances may dictate that benefits have to be altered or withdrawn for operating or other reasons.

The oldest of our locos – built in 1912 to a design dating back 30 years before that. Long-lived and well liked, they worked in East Anglian until 1962.

WD AUSTERTY



This rugged workhorse was built for the War Department in WWII. It saw service in Greece before returning to the UK in 1984.

WISSINGTON



Spent most of its working life hauling sugar beet near Downham Market. Holds the illustrious title of being the last working steam loco in Norfolk.

CLASS 31



Amongst the first diesel designs to work in East Anglia taking over from steam. It was delivered new to Norwich (32A) in 1960.

CLASS 04



Built in 1960 by Drewry/RSH. It is hoped to give the loco the outline of one of the class that worked the Wisbech & Upwell.
